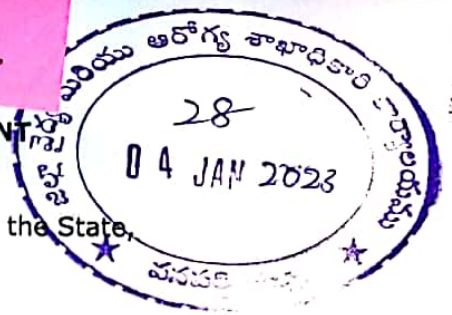

Sub: CH&FW - Esst. - Permission for engaging 1365 MLHPs positions on Contract basis of which (956) positions approved under 15th Finance Commission and to convert (409) MLHP positions under NHM - Guidelines and Schedule issued - Regarding.

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As you are aware, Government has accorded permission for engaging (956) new Mid-Level Health Providers (MLHP) positions approved under 15th Finance Commission vide reference 2nd cited.

Further, vide reference 1st cited above, permission was accorded to fill up (1569) posts. After taking up recruitment through the District Health Societies, (409) posts were reported as vacant by the District Medical & Health Officers. Thus, the total vacancies in the district are 1365.

The district wise vacant Sub centres for engaging Mid-Level Health Providers (MLHP) is shown in Annexure - I (1365).

In this regard, the District Selection Committees headed by District Collectors are requested to take necessary action to fill up these posts on contract basis for a period of one year. The guidelines for engaging MLHPs are appended to this letter.

It is requested to show personal interest and complete the recruitment process as per the timelines given following the guidelines enclosed.

Guidelines for recruitment of Mid Level Health Providers (MLHPS) on contract basis.

1) Application shall be invited by the respective District Selection Committees headed by the District Collectors.

2) Selection shall be done as per the following priority:

- (i) MLHP posts of sub centres (HWCs) that are located in municipal areas should be filled with MBBS/BAMS doctors only with preference being given to MBBS doctors.
- (ii) MLHP posts of sub centres (HWCs) that are located in other than municipal areas, the recruitment shall be done in the following order of priority;
 - (a) Doctor (MBBS/BAMS), with preference being given to MBBS
 - (b) Staff Nurse with B.SC (Nursing) who are graduated from the academic year 2020 onwards (or) Staff Nurse with B.Sc(Nursing)/GNM who graduated before the academic year 2020 and who completed 6 months bridge programme in Community Health (CPCH).

3) The District wise number of positions in Health and Wellness Centres for engaging MLHPS is appended as Annexure-I.

4) In the Health and Wellness Centres located in Municipal areas, the positions will first be filled up with MBBS doctors as per eligibility. After exhausting the MBBS doctors, these vacancies will be filled with BAMS doctors as per eligibility.

5) In the Health and Wellness centres located in Non-Municipal Areas, the position will first be filled up with MBBS doctors as per eligibility. After exhausting the MBBS doctors these vacancies will be filled with BAMS doctors as per eligibility. If no doctors are available then these positions can be filled up by Staff Nurse as per the eligibility.

6) **Age:** As prescribed by government vide G.O.Ms.No.42 Gen.Admin (Ser.A) Dept., Dt: 19.03.2022, the minimum and maximum age is 18 years and 44 years respectively. The upper age limit prescribed above however relaxed in the following cases:

10) District Selection Committee (DSC):

Recruitment shall be done by the District Selection on behalf of the District Health Societies.

11) Selection Procedure:

- Selections will be done based on the **combined percentage of marks obtained in all years** of MBBS/BAMS/B.Sc (Nursing)/GNM (For 100 marks).

Rule of Reservation shall be followed as per Government Orders from time to time.

- (iii) Presidential Orders 2018 has to be followed. As per Presidential Orders 2018, MBBS and BAMS doctors are Multi Zonal posts and Staff Nurse are zonal posts.
- (iv) Since, Health and Wellness centres located in Municipal Areas are to be filled up by only MBBS/BAMS doctors, they will be permitted to opt for either urban or rural Health and Wellness Centres are both.
- (v) Roster has to be followed.
- (vi) Notification shall be issued by DSC.



4	Display of Provisional Merit list and Call for objections	10.01.2023
5	Last Date of Receipt of objections and reply to candidate	11.01.2023
6	Display of Final Merit list and Selection list	12.01.2023
7	Conduct counselling and issue of Appointment Orders	13.01.2023

13) Other instructions

- a) The Selected MBBS and Staff Nurse Candidate have to undergo 2 weeks of induction training. The selected BAMS Candidates have to undergo bridge course program in Community Health (CPCH).
- b) After selection process is completed postings will be issued to the identified Health and Wellness Centres as per merit cum options.
